The Luria Library has over 115,000 (book) titles, 8 newspaper subscriptions and 318 print periodicals.

It takes 201 steps to get to the beach from the SBCC campus.

Students come from 75 different countries and 44 states.

With over 300 days of sunshine, the average temperature in Santa Barbara is around 70°.

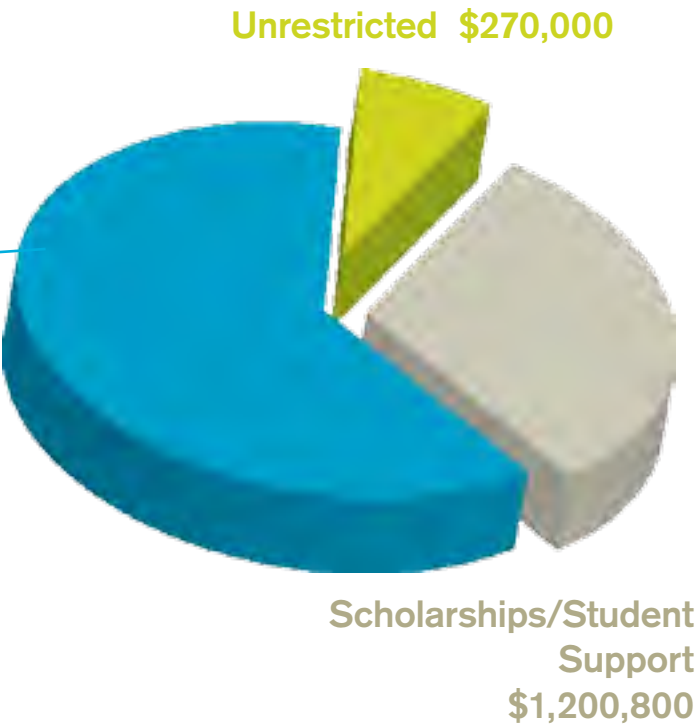

Champions for SBCC

Silvio Di Loreto—Board Member: A Foundation for SBCC Champion from the Start



One of two surviving original Foundation for SBCC board members, Silvio Di Loreto joined the Foundation Board of Directors in 1978 and served as President for four years, from 1983 to 1987. This was the period during which the first full-time Executive Director, Lana Rose, was hired (1983), and the first

professional fundraiser, James Minnow, began his tenure as Executive Director (1986).

Commercial real estate gifts to the Foundation in 1984 equaled one million dollars. Silvio employed his skills as a real estate professional helping to ensure long-term stable property income to the benefit of the Foundation's operating base.

As Foundation President, Silvio helped to organize the first Annual Fund Campaign for the Foundation, raising \$72,000, and established the first series of estate planning seminars sponsored by the Foundation. He was a Charter member of the President's Council organized in 1984-85 and has generously remembered the College in his estate planning.

Di Loreto Plaza on the West Campus was named in Silvio's honor for his service and financial support to the College during the Foundation's first private campaign to raise funds for new classroom buildings.

Silvio's community acknowledgments have included: "Realtor of the Year" in 1965; life-time Honorary Director of the California Real Estate Association since 1972; and the Anti-Defamation League's Distinguished Community Service Award in 1989.

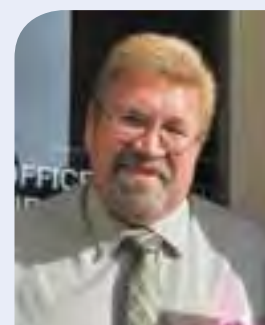
We would like to extend our deepest gratitude for all Silvio has done and continues to do for the students of SBCC. His legacy is their future.

Sonya Soltani, Class of 2012 Valedictorian

I was 19 years old when I left my friends and family to set sail on my academic ventures at Santa Barbara City College. Young and vulnerable, I wandered into hazy and unknown waters to drop anchor and find something out about myself. The feeling was much like what Henry David Thoreau must have felt while writing his classic novel *Walden*. The words “to suck out all the marrow of life” come to mind when asked why I enrolled in college.

In my time as a student at SBCC and an employee of many departments, I can say that I have done just that. Looking back, I am honored to say that I graduated from SBCC with double honors this year as the Spring 2012 Commencement Speaker. While this accomplishment is surreal to me in itself, I am still forced to face a grim truth. In 1983, one in five graduates were under or unemployed. Today, more than half of the class of 2012 is under or unemployed. Knowing this frightening statistic, I am scared, worried and afraid, but I take solace in the fact that I have shed sweat and tears in the last few years at an institution that is rated #1 in the state of California and one of the top ten in the nation. So, when the day of my first interview rolls around, I am so proud and honored to say that I studied at SBCC.

With the help of the Foundation for Santa Barbara City College, I was able to grow in my potential, discover many unknown talents, receive financial assistance for my studies, and become part of a family that truly cares for SBCC and its students. I utilized the Math Lab on West Campus at every opportunity, and I can honestly attribute my success in passing Elementary and Intermediate Algebra as well as Introduction to Statistics to the availability of the Math Lab on campus.

The Foundation for SBCC not only helped me in my studies, but also offered me a Fundraising Internship, and inversely, the opportunity to return the favor by helping to change the lives of SBCC students, who, much like myself at one point, needed the helping hand to lift them to the stars. And for that, I feel forever indebted. I feel indebted to SBCC, to the Foundation, and to the faculty and staff that helped me along the way. But don't worry; I'll pay my debt. My sails are stronger than when I came in, and I'll use all I took from SBCC to help guide me through the hazy seas to come.

Faculty Highlight

Kathy O'Connor, Athletics: An Example of Excellence On and Off the Field

Kathy O'Connor, SBCC's 2012 Faculty Lecturer, has been a resident of Santa Barbara for most of her life. After graduation from Carpinteria High School, she earned an AA degree from SBCC, a BS in Physical Education from UCSB, and an MA in Physical Education from Cal Poly San Luis Obispo.

She began her impressive career at Laguna Blanca (K-12) in Hope Ranch where she developed the girls physical education and athletics program while coaching and teaching. She moved on to Goleta Valley Junior High where she taught Science and Physical Education. Next came Kathy's career at SBCC where she was a part-time instructor in physical education for two years—during which she started the College's athletic program for women—before being hired full-time in 1976.

Kathy's years at SBCC have been characterized by her involvement in college governance. This has included twenty years on the Academic Senate and two years as its President; service on numerous Academic Senate committees, including Curriculum Advisory, Instructional Technology, Scholastic Standards, and Planning & Resources; and she continues to serve SBCC through College Planning Council, District Technology Committee and Matriculation. She was also among the first faculty members to develop distance-learning classes at

SBCC, and she has been an Athletic Academic Advisor for over 30 years.

Kathy has received several awards for teaching and professional excellence: the SBCC Faculty Excellence Award, the Hayward Award, the Community College Foundation Award for Outstanding Achievement in Technology Education, and the Louise Lowry Davis Sportswoman of the Year Award presented by the Santa Barbara Athletic Round Table.

The local community has also been the recipient of her dedication. As a horse-owner, she recognized the threat to horses posed by wildfires, and was Co-Founder and President of the Santa Barbara Equine Assistance and Evacuation Team, and she continues to be actively involved in providing training and educational opportunities for emergency services personnel and community members. Kathy has made presentations to community organizations on topics such as Fitness and Nutrition, Self-Defense for Women, Drug and Alcohol Education, and Women's Health Issues.

Kathy believes she and other educators have an important responsibility to their students. "Educators make a difference when they help students overcome their fears and develop the courage to live by a set of values that will reinforce their self-esteem and self-respect. As teachers, we can only do this if we lead with our hearts, maintain high standards and, most importantly, serve as excellent examples," said Kathy.

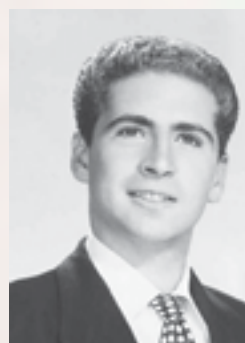

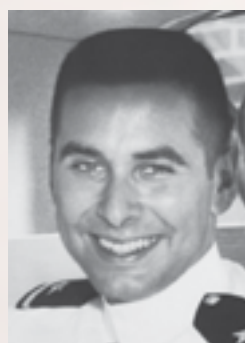

Transitions: From Incarceration to Education



Santa Barbara City College's Transitions Program was a recipient of the State Chancellor's Office 2012 John W. Rice Diversity and Equity Award.

85 percent of Transitions program participants complete the summer program and 90 percent of these successful participants enroll and attend fall semester at Santa Barbara City College.

The Foundation for SBCC has expanded the innovative program serving high school students who would otherwise be unlikely to pursue a college education. The Foundation hosted a private reception on May 9th, at Giannfranco's Trattoria, to announce the launch of Running Start 2.

Running Start 2 is an expansion of SBCC's Running Start Program. In addition to the six-week summer program, Running Start 2 will provide select high school graduates without plans to attend college—many without plans at all—with scholarships for tuition, books, tutoring, college orientation, academic counseling and guidance through the registration and financial aid application processes—for one full year, so that these students have all the tools they need to complete their first year successfully, and in turn, have a higher likelihood of completing college. Through Running Start, Program Coordinators identify and recruit high school seniors whose grades and test scores reflect their ability to succeed, but who are unaware of the benefits of higher education.

The Foundation for SBCC has committed to support the program for five years. Fundraising for Running Start 2 was spearheaded by Foundation Board Secretary, **Kandy Luria-Budgor** who recruited a team of "Angels" to support the expanded program.

Angels may take a more active role with the program's students and create partnerships and strategies that will help support student success, such as teaching leadership and life skills. The Angels that attended the reception included

Anne Towbes, Kandy Luria-Budgor, Maryan and Dick Schall, Victoria Mann Simms, Phyllis Mozilo, Claudia Lapin and Sarah Jane Lind.

Center for Sustainability: The (Adam) GREENing of SBCC

As an ecologist, I look for connections and the underlying science and apply ecological principles to the design of human systems. We have thus far designed human systems that poorly track our impact on the surrounding environment. Strong evidence suggests we

and create regional community based solutions. Our work involves campus operations, curriculum, and community. We don't see separation between the classroom and community and we feel that the College must serve as an example and living laboratory.

We use a solutions based approach where students and collaborators seek to understand the issue and help find a solution that benefits everyone. Our programs reflect our commitment and process.

The One Planet Faculty training program sponsored by **Merryl Brown and William E. Weiss Foundation**

provides information to faculty so that they can develop activities in their own discipline that educates students about sustainability.

School Gardens, a **partnership with the Orfalea Foundation**, has installed

nearly 30 gardens in elementary schools throughout the county and is reconnecting children to their food and their environment using standards based curriculum in the garden.

Our community education program sponsored by the **Tomchin Family Trust** and run by the Center's coordinator, Margie Bushman, paid by funds from the **Danner Family Trust**, has created 2 main themes. The first inspired by Gunther Pauli's work seeks to investigate opportunities in sustainable business. The second addresses the urban environment and explores the concept of Cities as the Solution.

Many other projects are initiated by students through the Projects in Sustainability class.

have, as a result, come to a crisis point. I feel that we can use the motivation of this crisis to achieve a more integrated educational program that produces better trained students and more ecologically sound designs to create a healthy, high quality of life that also regenerates and sustains the environment upon which we depend. Because so many systems can and should be redesigned, this concept is relevant to every student. As Frank Rhodes, President Emeritus of Cornell University stated, "The concept of sustainability could provide a new foundation for the liberal arts and sciences." Furthermore, every sector of our economy and every career path will affect and will be affected by the state of the environment so training in this area is vital to the success of our graduates and our community.

The Center for Sustainability is founded on the principle that every system needs some redesign and that a community college is an ideal place to inspire students

Mesa Harmony Gardens converted 2/3 of an acre of dead lawn at a local church to a food forest generating produce for the Foodbank and education for the community.

The SBCC community market brings local organic fruits and vegetables to the SBCC campus each week.

The Santa Barbara "Where's Your Bag" campaign had its start with a student project.

The campus cob bench exemplifies how we can build using waste and local materials. Students diverted hundreds of pounds of waste from the landfill and created a useful educational sculpture.

We live in challenging times. Environmental degradation has reached a crisis point with biodiversity loss, dwindling fresh water supplies, and pollution including what may be our greatest threat, climate change. We can make a difference together, starting right here on the SBCC campus and in our community.

The Luria Library: Explore. Learn. Grow.

The Luria Library offers a dynamic, innovative, and exciting place for students to learn. The library responds to the needs and learning styles of today's student, helping them achieve their learning outcomes, enrich their lives, establish careers, and see the value of libraries in relationship to their learning. Our tag line is: **Explore. Learn. Grow.**

The library was commended by the accrediting agency for our "extensive use of innovative communication technology by library faculty to reach out and provide services to students; and enhancing student engagement through partnerships with faculty and the development of directed learning activities which extend classroom instruction into the tutorial environment."

In recent years, significant changes to staff, collection and technology resources, programming, and services have resulted in a wave of student attendance,

enhanced collaboration with faculty members and recognition by other state and national community colleges as a leader in community college library programming. Significant and continual steps have been made to change the library from a quiet, under-utilized, unappealing environment to one that is active, dynamic and responsive to student needs. A doubling in physical library use in recent years demonstrates this change dramatically, along with an equivalent increase of classes taught by librarians and significantly enhanced interactions with faculty. The Luria Library is a dynamic, vital hub of the campus.

On average more than 4,000 students visit the library per day. We are open 7-days a week and our services are available well beyond the regular hours of building operation – vastly increasing accessibility to library resources.

When creating a library environment that is welcoming,

outreach and activities are essential. The library regularly hosts events which draw students to hear poets, playwrights, faculty members, student panelists. Special events include the Edible Book Festival and Day of the Dead exhibition.

The library supports the College's mission by providing an environment that is both intellectually and physically supportive of students. The online environment of the library mirrors this support by providing an exceptional portal to the services, staff and resources of the library at a low cost. As such it is a model for other community colleges.

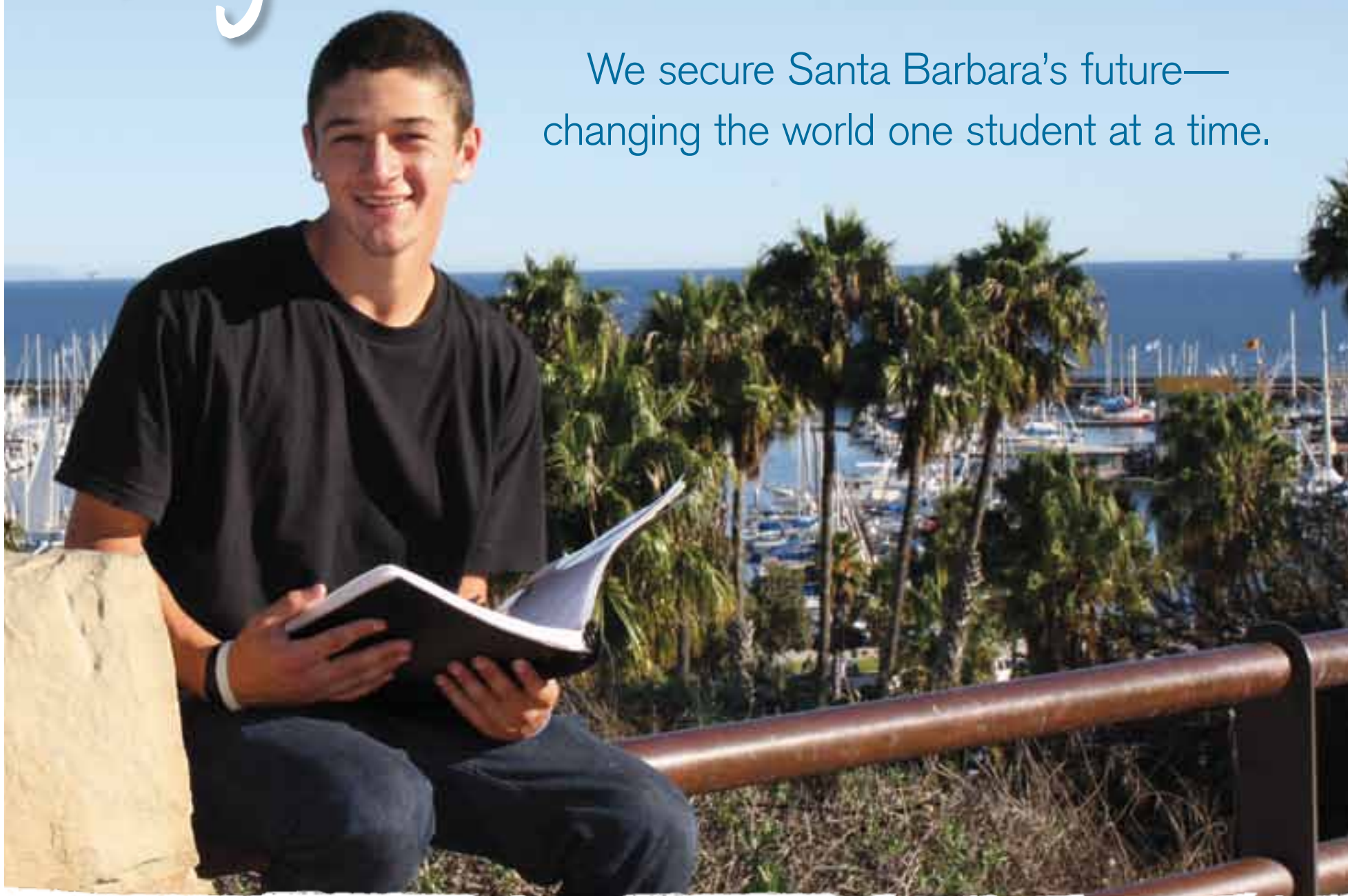
